CAMDEN AREA CHRISTIAN FOOD PANTRY EXPANDS FACILITY

The Camden Area Christian Food Pantry recently completed construction on an addition to the pantry that will house shelving, refrigeration units, a work table area and extra storage space. The addition has alleviated very crowded conditions in the original part of the building and allows procurement of larger quantities of food and supplies for the families the pantry serves. The expanded building will allow us to serve even more families.

CACFP was founded by a local group of five Christian churches including Chestnut Street Baptist, First Congregational, John Street Methodist, Our Lady of Good Hope and St. Thomas Episcopal. The pantry was established to provide food to those in need in Camden, Rockport, Lincolnville, Hope, Appleton, Searsmont, Union and Washington. Families are welcome to come once a week during open hours on Tuesdays from 8:00-11:00 AM or Thursdays from 4:00-6:00 PM. We are located at 128 Mt Battie St in Camden (just off Washington St).
