1. Convene, 7 p.m., (Gushee, Wyman, Fenner, Beckett, Costigan)
2. Reminder: Meetings are recorded.
3. Costigan: Motion to approve warrant #14, school payroll, \$36,415.25; #15, \$4,059.87, town payroll; and, #16, town expenses, \$56,091.21. Beckett: Second. Unanimous.
4. Beckett: Motion to approve minutes of August 7, 2018. Gushee: Second. 4-0-1 (Wyman abstained due to absence.)
5. Town Speed Sign: Tongue for trailer needs to be installed to move. Awaiting Road Commissioner.
6. Tax Bill Message: A reminder can be inserted on a separate card. The bottom of the bill is not available for additional town messages. Beckett and Costigan to draft.
7. Pine Grove Cemetery: Fenner and Gushee to explore remaining lots at the pre-2017 sizing of the newly expanded area. (Potentially two or three lots remain.)
8. Road Commissioner: Absent during blueberry harvest.
9. Tri-County Solid Waste: The transfer station will post closing at 4:20 p.m. Lincoln County Recycling has increased by 34 percent due to costs of recycling. Beckett to research profit and loss of recycled material and relationship to annual charge. Tri-County Solid Waste information meeting will take place September 19, 6:30, Vose Library, Union.
10. Pine Grove Cemetery: Gushee to contact David Bragg on pruning.
11. Public Comment: Arlene Kellman registered a complaint regarding potholes on Collinstown Road.
12. Tax Bills: Mil rate should be set by September following completion of valuation assessments. (2017 mil rate voted September 19th.) Fred Brown asked if established mil rate could be published in local newspapers.
