

**Appleton Select Board
February 20, 2018**

1. Convene, 7:03 p.m. (Beckett, Fenner, Wiley, Gushee, Costigan)
2. Reminder: Meetings are recorded.
3. Motion to approve minutes of February 13, 2018, Costigan. Second, Wiley. 4-0-1; Gushee abstained due to absence.
4. Motion to sign the ATV lease between the town and Darryl Grierson, EMS, Gushee. Second, Wiley. Unanimous.
5. Table possible plow contract extension discussion until next week. Contract and town meeting allow three-year contract with the possibility of a fourth year.
6. Other: Gushee spoke with Mark Vannah, forester, who indicated stumpage for Herb Collamore lot is \$20,000. Suggested that should be the reserve for a potential town auction, if approved by voters. Beckett mentioned an upcoming training by Knox Lincoln Soil and Water Conservation District for non-traditional solutions to gravel roads later this year.
7. Tim Fowler, resident, owner of Sennebec Campground, reports Tidewater Telecom does not extend to his residence/business. Time Warner/Spectrum Television has told him they would provide a line. Town does not have an agreement with Time Warner. Fenner to review Tidewater contract.
8. Road Commissioner: Exemption permits for restricted roads. Motion to exempt subsection c from Permits criteria failed for lack of a second. Move to adopt exemption certificate as presented by the road commissioner (sourced from MDOT and MMA), Fenner. Second, Beckett. Unanimous.
9. Road Commissioner: Roads have been posted. Culvert installed at Collinstown. No record of permit application for CMP; CMP informed to file culvert application. Sand arrived, 480+yards. 850-900 yards to date for the winter.
10. Other: New employee at the transfer station, according to Beckett. Carry forward funds go into general fund.
11. Motion to adjourn, 8 p.m. Unanimous.
