November 13, 2018**

1. Convene, 7 p.m. (Wyman, Fenner, Beckett, Costigan)
2. Reminder: Meetings are recorded.
3. Wyman: Motion to approve minutes of 11/6/2018. Beckett: Second. Unanimous.
4. Forestry: Fenner and Wyman meeting with Robbins Forester Mark Vannah Thursday regarding Midcoast Lot, cutting to date and resource maps.
5. Weekly Expense Reports: Clerk will reduce number of copies printed for board and will submit via email to assist savings. Hard copies will be printed for chair and as requested.
6. Review article for tax information on website: Disclaimer for “If this article is approved, the authorization shall continue annually unless modified by the voters” should be considered on future articles as article from years ago lacked disclaimer. Will revisit in 2019 town meeting.
(Names and addresses will continue to be removed from online assessment information in interim.)
7. Broadband: Wyman met with Jay Feyler and will continue to gauge interest in expanding broadband via federal funding. Current thought from Feyler is to include Guinea Ridge, Fishtown, Collinstown and Union roads could be eligible for federal funding with input from residents. CSD use of work-from-home snow days could assist grant application.
8. Pettengill Culvert: DOT funding cycle will be announced in 2019 and beginning Army Corps studies is advised by DEP officials. DEP staffer Bill Longfellow will meet Nov 28th, 10 a.m. at the library (Or town office) and will review requirements and benchmarks for grants as such may pertain to the Pettengill culvert and potential bond funds from state for culvert repair. Requests for proposals likely to be posted in 2019.
