3. Costigan: Motion to approve warrants #108, \$70,207.19; #7, school expenses, \$186,621.44; #1, school activities account, \$78.27. Fenner: Second. 3-0-1/Garrigan.
4. Beckett: motion to approve minutes of July 16. Fenner: Second. 3-0-1/Garrigan, absence.

11. Road Commissioner: Inspected culvert on Jones Hill. Deemed functional at this time and homeowner has committed to checking. Whitney Road is getting washed out on the sides. Large oak struck by lightning and split. Resident has asked for removal or stabilization, however power lines would not be impacted in the event the tree fell from the right of way. Boyington will review. Washout repairs remain on to-do list.

Garrigan: Are we going to solicit the advice of an engineer for West Appleton Road at any time? (Fenner: USIFW help with beaver and whichever agency classified Pettengill as a potential salmon habitat) 6/10ths of a mile of poor pavement in addition

Cemetery Plantings: Costigan: The town's responsibility for the cemeteries in the absence of an association brings to question if there is a need for long-term plantings of larger trees and shrubs along road lines, etc. Fenner: Road crowning on the cemetery roadways is also problematic for cars.
