1. Convene, 7 p.m. (Fenner, Garrigan, Costigan)
2. Reminder: Meetings are recorded.
3. Costigan: Motion to approve warrant #8, school payroll, \$36,096.68; #9, \$2,857.64, town payroll; #10, \$12,684.85, town expenses; and #11, \$487.26, school expenses. Fenner: Second. Unanimous.
4. Fenner: Motion to approve minutes of July 23, 2019. Garrigan: Second. Unanimous.
5. Public Comment: None.
6. Committee Updates: Garrigan updated TCSWO. Beckett has become treasurer. President remains John Shepherd. Management of solid waste is putting logging of woodlot out to bid.
7. Road Commissioner: Power brake on Sennebec Road damaged roadway. Laying calcium chloride on Appleton Ridge Road to control dust. Holding off on grading due to dryness and creation of potholes.
8. Appointments: Fenner: Motion to appoint the following to three-year terms to the fire department: Brian Sullivan, Glenn Fowlie, David Stone, Matthew Dixon, Austin Stark, Donald Grierson, Benjamin Larner, Kelli Stark, Barry King, Kevin Grierson, Brendan Allen, Lester Brown, Charles Buell, Belinda Williams. Garrigan: Second. Unanimous.
9. West Appleton Road: Fenner spoke with the state fish and game regarding beavers and agency will grant permits whenever needed to facilitate removal. Advice was to start with beavers and deal with dams later. State can recommend to trappers areas with problem beavers. Fenner also emailed federal fish and wildlife regarding salmon status of Pettengill. Identification is of habitat, not actual species. Designation for construction criteria will come from Army Corps of Engineers, which has been contacted.
