3. Costigan: Motion to approve warrants #80, school accounts payable, \$63, 573.75; #81, school renovation, \$7,800.00. Beckett: Second. Unanimous.
4. Beckett: Motion to approve minutes of March 12, 2019. Gushee: Second. Unanimous.
5. Public Comment: Charlie Garrigan: Regarding Sebago Technic Maps, why are they important when Appleton does not have zoning? Costigan: It's more of an assessing tool; satellite images tied to maps allows for better accuracy in assessing.
