APPROVE MINUTES OF JULY 27, 2021 MEETING: Motion moved by Beckett, second Blakely. Unanimous approval.

AUTHORIZE CHAIR TO SIGN CMP LED AGREEMENT: Material provided regarding Brightness. Minor changes suggested, motion to authorize Costigan to sign contract as amended Becket, second Esancy. Unanimous vote of approval.
