REVIEW OF JUNE 29 MINUTES: Motion to approve with edits, Beckett. Second by Garrigan. Unanimous.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Bucklin discussed public access to body of water for recreation/swimming. Wadsworth inquired about the town clerk opening.

ROAD COMMISSIONER: Started mowing, got a lot done. Working on other projects and will resume mowing likely Thursday. Not much change from last week and no purchase orders requested. Will look into additional speed sign. Discussion regarding replacing street signs as needed.

AWARD PAVING BID: Allstate Asphalt low bid for Collinstown and West Appleton Rd. Motion to award contract for project one \$90,898.08 and two \$65,050.80 as well as permission for Lorie to sign the contract Beckett. Second by Garrigan. Unanimous.

MMA RISK PREVENTION/FIRE DEPARTMENT: MMA survey crew visited in May found eye wash station to be inspected monthly, fire extinguishers in both town office and fire station to be inspected monthly and air compressor did not have proper pressurization but is equipment no longer in use. MMA updated of progress.

RESIGNATION: Dave Schofield has resigned effective today. Motion to accept David Schofield's resignation with regret Beckett. Second: Garrigan. Unanimous.

APPOINTMENTS: Appoint Corey Fortin of Washington as CEO for one year, motion Beckett, second Garrigan. Unanimous.

TASTING EVENT APPROVAL MAINE WILD BLUEBERRY WEEKEND (AUGUST 7-8):

State Department of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms requires select board vote for Application for blueberry wine tasting. Motion to approve application for Wild Maine Blueberry Weekend Beckett. Second Garrigan. Unanimous.

OTHER: \$45,040.00 eligible funding available from road improvement program for this fiscal year, typically funds delivered end of December. Minor outdoor lighting and internal lighting work to be looked at and bids submitted.
