APPROVE MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 28, 2021 Motion to approve minutes Esancy, second Blakely. Unanimous vote of approval

ROAD COMMISSIONER Paving crew is in Warren, so anticipate they are on schedule to be here on Thursday. If anything, different, will update via email. Minimal work to do on West Appleton Road tomorrow. Have started grading roads that need it, some sections that will not be graded because they do not need it. Material hauled to Snow Hill Road last week to repair erosion. Cement truck used side access to Belfast turn intersection and spilled some concrete that will need to be chipped out of the roadway. Beavers have returned to some problematic areas, Esancy will look into trappers to potentially address the issue. Motion for purchase order for sand mixing, pushing, etc. not to exceed \$1,800 Costigan, second Esancy. Unanimous vote of approval. Motion for purchase order for West Appleton curve material for Hartland for \$1,950.00 Costigan, second Blakely. Unanimous vote of approval.

DISCUSS TOWN FOREST LOGGING SCHEDULE Esancy has looked into foresting town owned properties when needed. In years past, Robbins lumber has lent a hand to identify wood ready to harvest. It does not appear there is a requirement for a special town meeting for this topic and appears the funds are designated to conservation. Will reach out to the necessary people to address harvesting needs on the Lower Road and Collinstown Roads which are slated to be done next.

OTHER Esancy spoke with a resident who is interested in filing a formal complaint regarding conditions at Pine Grove Cemetery.

Esancy spoke with David Bragg this morning and he may be available later this week to conduct another follow through at the cemetery and will reach out accordingly.

Also contacted by a citizen regarding some deep furrows on Burkettville hill which is a state-maintained road. Will reach out to the designated point of contact.
