  - a. Katie Tagai of Midcoast Council of Governments discussed grant opportunities related to culverts and the town's participation in resiliency planning. MCOG is able to assist with all application efforts.
  - b. ACO discussion: Continued until full board is present and state statutes disseminated.
  - c. Collinsontown Complaint Update: CEO Conant reported progress on the installation of a simple subsurface wastewater system and noted the occupant of the parcel is attempting to follow state guidelines. More documentation is required for final inspection, including of the greywater system. In general, Conant reported the tenant is "moving toward compliance."
  - d. Costigan: Motion to adopt the GA standards set by the State of Maine. Esancy: Second, Unanimous, without comment.
  - e. Esancy: Motion to approve abatement Map 29, Lot 001. Reed: Second. Unanimous.
  - f. Other: Esancy discussed private waste disposal options and noted the Town of Belmont uses a private contractor. Esancy is currently reviewing private contracts and determining how many residents use curbside dumpster services and notes that Tri County accepts waste from residents of non-participating towns.
  - g. Materials purchased from ARC for the pathways of Getchell Park was discussed with preference for moving and placing materials at the same time, rather than using the upland portion as materials storage.
