1. Convene, 7 p.m. (Fenner, Beckett, Gushee, Wiley, Costigan)
2. Sign warrants: #101, \$1,300.60, school renovation, #100, \$55,573.19, school expenses.
3. Reminder: Meetings are recorded.
4. Motion to approve May 9, 2017 minutes, Beckett. Second, Wiley. Unanimous.
5. Sign Warrant for Annual Town Meeting.
6. Update on sale of remaining Ames Addition lot. Potential buyer concerned by rock and potential size of rock on lot. Wait and remove in conjunction with other cemetery work. Wiley researched comparative cemetery lot prices.
7. Motion to reappoint Steven Powers as Town Forrester, Beckett. Second, Wiley. Unanimous.
8. Paving Collinstown Rd. (west/chip seal) and E. Sennebec Road (asphalt) needs to go out to bid.
9. Motion to hold select board meeting at 5, May 23, Gushee. Second, Beckett. Unanimous. (Due to CSD vote later in the evening.)
10. Motion to cancel select board meeting due to conflict with elections June 13, Beckett. Second, Wiley. Unanimous.
11. Road Commissioner Update: Entrance permit request for Ben Magro on Peabody Road. Motion to approve brush-cutting purchase orders for Gushee Road, Guinea Ridge, Miller Cemetery roads, Gushee. Second, Fenner. Unanimous. (No need for purchase order for Lime Kiln/Magog side.) Plan for dirt roads to resurface dirt roads with gravel following grading work. Some side roads lack gravel altogether. Children at Play signs for Sennebec Road.
12. Public Comment: Kal Winer regarding Guinea Ridge Road grading. He questions what we are getting for road grading funds. "Like a coat of paint on a rotten surface." Gravel planned for dirt roads using existing road improvement funds.
13. Other: Monthly personnel meetings with staff beginning in June.
