

Municipal Officers' Notice of Public Hearing on Secret Ballot Referendum Issue

Notice is hereby given that the Municipal Officers of the Town of Appleton will hold a public hearing on Thursday, November 18, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the Appleton Town Office in Appleton to hear public comment on the following Articles for the November 30, 2021 Special Town Meeting Referendum:

Article 1: "Shall the Town approve an expenditure from surplus, not to exceed \$80,000, to purchase 4 acres on Sherman's Mill Pond – Map 22 Lot 018 – to create the Getchell Family Park to preserve freshwater access, provide future recreational opportunity, and provide a location for a dry fire hydrant water source for the Town of Appleton?"

And

Article 2: "Shall the Town pursue and, if available, accept funding through the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Land for Maine's Future, American Recovery Plan Act, and others toward the purchase of the parcel described in Article 1?"

Pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2528(5), we have this day, being at least seven days before the hearing, notified the inhabitants of Appleton of a public hearing, to be held at the time and place, and for the purposes stated above, by posting a copy of said notice at the following public and conspicuous places in Appleton: Appleton Town Office, Burketville General Store, Appleton Library.
